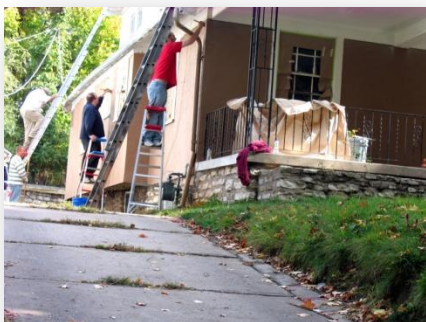
Paints an Expression of Love on KCK Homes
