CALL THE MEETING TO ORDER:

REVIEW OF THE MEETING MINUTES:

Review of the minutes from May 6, 2020. Motion made to accept the minutes as presented by Damon Mitchell. The board approved with no changes. Approved 5/8 members

NEWS/INFORMATIONAL/BOARD REQUESTS

Introduction of Calvin Johnson the new Administrator for Programs in Community Corrections.

- Director Phillip Lockman introduced Mr. Calvin Johnson the new Administrator for Programs. Mr. Johnson has numerous experiences with high risk clients and he just left as the Drug Court Coordinator for Community Corrections. He has been with Community Corrections for over 18 years. Mr. Johnson also mention to the board the different areas where he has previously worked either in Kansas or Oklahoma (Juvenile Officer, JUV Drug Court program, Adult Probation, Heart of America, Community Outreach, Johnson County Detox, Resource Center). Additionally, the former Drug Court Coordinator position will be closing tomorrow, and interviews will be conducted soon.
- Director Lockman also mentioned Jamie VanHouten our Behavioral Health Court Coordinator will be departing us soon to take the Leavenworth County Community Corrections Directors position in the new future. Once she leaves then the Department can look at posting her position.

Welcome to Captain Jason Allen who took over for Captain James Bauer with the KCK PD. Mr. Allen was not able to make the meeting today.

Approval of the FY 2020 Quarterly Budget Adjustment Report

- Director Phillip Lockman presented the board with the FY 2020 Quarterly Budget Adjustment Report. He stated this is the first year we were able to move money around and to have zero balanced for the end of the year. We were able to move funding from Salary, benefits, treatment/groups, medication, care coordinator and put it in Treatment/Groups under Behavioral Health Grant to cover the remaining year. We were also requesting to move funding from Fuel, PerDiem, vehicle maintenance, tolls, cell phone, and electronic monitoring and put it under salary, registration, benefits, REGIS, and misc under the Grant Funding.
- Director Lockman mention in this year's upcoming budget we received a \$50,000.00 cut, so we will not be filling an ISO position. Due to COVID 19 and the budget shortages the pay raise may not also occur. However, on the Behavioral Health Court Budget side, we did receive everything we requested.
- Chairman Mitchell asked for a motion. Ms. Clardy placed the motion and Mr. Ross 2nd the motion. Approved 5/8.

Update on Reducing SB 123 Absconders After Sentencing. Administrator Lockamy mention one of the FY 21 comp plan goals was to reduce SB 123 probationers from absconding after sentencing before they can attend treatment. He stated in FY 20, out of 23 probationers who were pre-screened and sentenced as a SB 123 (to attend inpatient) ten absconded directly after sentencing, before they got into treatment. Community Corrections in the future is going to work with Adult Court Services and treatment providers, so when the client gets sentenced, they can be released to Community Corrections and go straight to treatment. Ms. Clardy asked Administrator Lockamy if this was hard to do with the providers. Administrator Lockamy stated we normally start the process before sentencing and then we just must coordinate for the bed prior to sentencing.

Final update: Director Lockman informed the board members about the Juvenile floor moving to the new building around end of Sep/Oct 2020. When the 2nd floor opens in the current building the programs will move to the 2nd floor and drug court will move to the second floor of the current building.
