## Continuum of Care Funding Competition

### *Press release*

Kansas City, MO, July 3, 2019 — The FY 2019 Continuum of Care (CoC) Program Competition Notice of Funds Available (NOFA) has officially opened. This year, HUD is making available more than \$2.3 billion in funding to serve persons experiencing homelessness. The CoC Program is designed to promote a community-wide commitment to the goal of ending homelessness by providing funding for efforts pursued by nonprofit homeless service providers, healthcare providers, State and local governments, and more. These funds are used yearly to provide support to agencies working to quickly re-house homeless individuals, families, people fleeing domestic violence, homeless Veterans, and youth while minimizing the trauma and dislocation caused by homelessness. **To view the 2019 Continuum of Care Program Competition NOFA, [click here](#).**

The FY 2019 COC Program Competition submission deadline is **Monday, September 30, 2019 at 7:00PM Central Time. Please Note: Program applicants will have deadlines sooner than this date; please actively look for further information regarding project-specific deadlines on our website.**

Eligible project applicants for the CoC Program Competition are nonprofit organizations, States, local governments, and instrumentalities of State and local governments, and public housing agencies, as such term is defined in 24 CFR 5.100, without limitation or exclusion. For-profit entities are not eligible to apply for grants or to be subrecipients of grant funds. Individuals, foreign entities, and sole proprietorship organizations are not eligible to compete for, or receive, awards made under this announcement. Applicants must apply using HUD's e-SNAPs application system.

As in years past, this program is open to all agencies that fit under the eligibility requirements laid out by HUD as seen above. Any local agencies or programs providing applicable homeless housing services are strongly encouraged to apply. More information, important dates to remember, deadlines, and requirements will soon be published on [our website](#), and will remain accessible throughout the competition process.
