YOU ARE INVITED TO ATTEND a Unified Government virtual public hearing to be held on Thursday evening, June 11, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. To reduce the spread of COVID-19 and consistent with County and State Orders limiting gatherings of individuals to 10 persons or less, the meetings of the Unified Government Board of Commission will be conducted remotely using Zoom, an online meeting tool. The public hearing is sponsored by the Unified Government of Wyandotte County/Kansas City, Kansas Community Development Department. The purpose of this meeting is to request public comment for the Unified Government's revised Citizen Participation Plan. Revisions include adding the Determination of Urgent Need Section which states:

Upon determination of urgent need, and in accordance with HUD approved regulatory waivers to 24 CFR 91.105(c)(2) and (k), and 24 CFR 91.401, the Citizen Participation plan allows expedited procedures to draft, propose, or amend consolidated and annual action plans. Expedited procedures must include notice and reasonable opportunity to comment of no less than 5 days. The 5-day period can run concurrently for comments on the action plan amendment and amended citizen participation plan.

These changes are, in part, due to the availability of waivers of U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Community Planning and Development Grant Program and Consolidated Plan Requirements to Prevent the Spread of COVID-19 and Mitigate Economic Impacts Caused by COVID-19.
