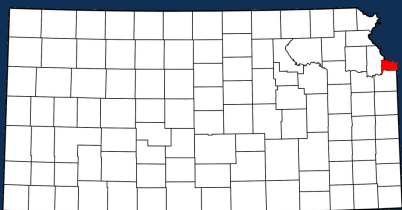
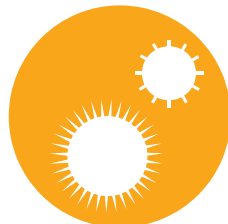
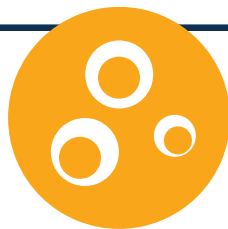

GET TESTED

GET TREATED
