PICK YOUR SPOT

IT'S FUN

The Unified Government of Wyandotte County/Kansas City, Kansas' Adopt-A-Spot program is voluntary, designed for civic-minded groups or businesses with an interest in keeping Bonner Springs, Edwardsville, and KCK litter-free. It is open to families, youth organizations, civic groups, non-profit organizations, churches, schools, social organizations, neighborhood groups, service organizations, retiree organizations, and city, county, or state agencies.

WHAT'S ADOPTABLE?

The Unified Government has identified numerous streets, parks, and Land Bank properties in Bonner Springs, Edwardsville, and KCK as adoptable. Check out the full list of adoptable spots on the SOAR website at wycokck.org/SOAR/Adopt.

WHO CAN ADOPT-A-SPOT?

Anyone can Adopt-A-Spot, but there's a catch, right? Yes - kind of. For safety reasons, volunteers participating in clean up efforts on adopted portions of street must be over 14 years of age. Otherwise, Adopt-A-Spot is open to everyone!
