**BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION:** The Maternal Child and Health Program is seeking a Community Health Worker (CHW) to provide Universal Home Visiting services for pregnant woman, mothers, and infants up to 12 months of age. The CHW will provide a population -based approach to Universal Home Visiting by providing at minimum of one home visit. The clients will be screened and educated on all components of the Universal Home Visiting Tools. The CHW will support specific programs and community partners. This includes identifying clients needs, helping enroll them in available programs and following up as needed. The CHW will promote infant and child health, foster educational development and to help families to become more self-sufficient. The CHW needs to be comfortable going into the home and community setting.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:** High School diploma or GED and one year of related experience in the area of assignment; or, an equivalent combination of education and experience sufficient to successfully perform the essential duties of the position. Community Health Worker Certificate and experience in working with maternal health field preferred. Bilingual in Spanish/English is desirable.
