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BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION: The Environmental Compliance Supervisor position in the Department of Air Quality (DAQ) shares the responsibility of supervising staff in the DAQ and the Environmental Health Section of the Health Department. Duties include; supervising staff, assisting in interviewing, and selecting employees; ensuring appropriate training of personnel; planning prioritizing and budgeting the program; supervising implementation of special projects; review of and input into routine staff work conducting field work and inspections. This position requires knowledge of Federal, State, and local regulations and policies with respect to air quality as well as knowledge of supervisory principles.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Bachelor's Degree in Environmental Health, Community Health, Public health, Engineering or related field and three years of environmental compliance or pretreatment inspections experience; or any equivalent combination of education and experience sufficient to successfully perform the essential duties of the job such as those listed above.
