BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION: This position is responsible for supervising adult felons placed on Behavioral Health Court (BHC) supervision within community corrections; prepare weekly court reports, court recommendations and attend court weekly to provide testimony on participant progress. Minimum contact standards required to monitor and verify participant compliance with court orders, treatment, UA's and pro-social behavior within the community. Participant in BHC team meetings and provide meaningful input into the court process. Work closely with participants providers and team members to address identified areas of risk/need to reduce recidivism and promote recovery, adhering to the key components and best practices of the BHC model.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Bachelor's degree in corrections, criminal justice or a human service field or an equivalent combination of education and experience sufficient to successfully perform the essential duties of the job such as those cited above. Knowledge of problem-solving courts with an understanding of the role substance addiction and mental health issues play in the cognitive process is preferred. Must have a valid driver's license and car insurance.
