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BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION: Successful candidate will be instrumental in the development, implementation, and support/maintenance of Body Worn Camera (BWC)/in car camera solution. This position serves as the Primary Point of Contact with the BWC/In Car vendor. This position will be responsible for deployment and support of BWC/In Car, BWC/In Car Database and Storage Maintenance, handle all warranty and maintenance issues regarding BWC/In Car, provide end user support, provide KORA request and redaction support, perform regular audits and assist with video categorization. This position is responsible for maintaining an inventory of all BWC/In Car Camera and installation of new and modified hardware/software to facilitate functionality of BWC/In Car software/hardware and other integrated software/hardware. This position will be responsible for providing training to end users and may be required to testify in court. An incumbent in this classification is on-call to respond to system malfunction.
