

We had three homicides last week. All were solved due in part to good community input.

Class now training with 11 total, two lateral candidates, one from Leavenworth Ks and one from New Mexico.

They expect 18 – 20 in next academy class.

Dispatch are still short 19 positions, with 25% of positions working with average of 1 year.

Animal services personnel have received vests for their protection. The vest will have different markings than the PD.

Sheriff Ash

New class April 1 had 5 persons. They received 3 applications in March and all tested ok.

Still short 20 Deputies in the detention side of the department.

The population in the Juvenile Justice Building (maximum of 40) is 10 with 9 from WyCo and 1 from Leavenworth. The state of Kansas is looking at the possibility of regional centers for their youth offenders with WyCo as one of the possibilities.
