- UG Ordinance . . . (Ord. No. O-62-06, Sec. 2-752 Duties)

   a. "to advise the unified commission, county administrator, the sheriff and the chief of police on existing and potential law enforcement problems in the county . . . and"
   b. "to . . . serve as an informational liaison between the sheriff's department, the police department and the citizenry at large on law enforcement activities, programs and initiatives."
- 2) State statute includes . . . (KS Statute 22-4610)

a. "advise and assist in policy development, education and community outreach and communication related to racial or other biased based policing by law enforcement officers and agencies."

b. "Receive training on fair and impartial policing and comprehensive plans for law enforcement agencies."
