LEAB Duties and Responsibilities according to ordinance and statute.

- 1) **UG Ordinance** . . . (Ord. No. O-62-06, Sec. 2-752 - Duties)
 - a. “to advise the unified commission, county administrator, the sheriff and the chief of police on existing and potential law enforcement problems in the county . . . and”
 - b. “to . . . serve as an informational liaison between the sheriff’s department, the police department and the citizenry at large on law enforcement activities, programs and initiatives.”
- 2) **State statute** includes . . . (KS Statute 22-4610)
 - a. “advise and assist in policy development, education and community outreach and communication related to racial or other biased based policing by law enforcement officers and agencies.”
 - b. “Receive training on fair and impartial policing and comprehensive plans for law enforcement agencies.”
