Fiscal Sponsorship Guidelines

A Fiscal Sponsor is generally a 501(c)(3) public charity that provides fiduciary oversight, financial management and possibly other administrative services related to charitable projects that further the Fiscal Sponsor's own tax-exempt purposes.

Although each fiscal sponsorship relationship is unique, a fiscal sponsorship generally includes at least the following, which are described in a written agreement:

- The Fiscal Sponsor receives and acknowledges charitable contributions.
- The Fiscal Sponsor retains complete control and discretion over the funds.
- The Fiscal Sponsor ensures the funds are used for tax-exempt purposes that further the Fiscal Sponsor's own tax-exempt purposes.
- The Fiscal Sponsor maintains records that show use of the funds for appropriate tax-exempt purposes.
- The Sponsored Organization complies with recordkeeping and reporting requested by the Fiscal Sponsor so the Fiscal Sponsor can fulfill its oversight responsibilities.
