






#### Years of Potential Life Lost due to Homicide by Race





### Percentage of Wyandotte County Residents Reporting Chronic Diseases









Many factors can contribute to chronic diseases. Reducing smoking, poor nutrition, physical inactivity, and excessive alcohol use can all reduce chronic diseases.






Wyandotte hospital admission rate per 10,000 (2018-2020)

### **Obesity rate in Wyandotte County (2020)**








**Kansas Median Household Income**






